TERRY'S THOUGHTS

As I laid in bed attempting to sleep the other night the Lord impressed on me a subject for this newsletter article and perhaps for a future sermon. The thought I had surrounded the word "Unity." According to the Webster's All-In-One dictionary the word "unity" means, "The quality or state of being or being made one." From a spiritual point of view this definition applies to us as we begin our journey with Jesus Christ. Once Jesus has entered into a relationship with us, we become one with Him. This oneness assures us of our eternal destiny and reassures us here in the present while we endure the world in which we must live.

Being one with Jesus gives us the ability to follow the Lord's will for our lives, stand up to our common enemy when attacked, and experience victory over our enemy while trusting Jesus with all things. The term unity was such an important issue for the Colossian church (us as well) that the Apostle Paul included the idea of unity in his instructions to the Colossians. These characteristics that Paul admonished us to follow should be readily visible in all Christians, "Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering; bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you so you also must do. But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection (unity in the CSB)" (NKJV). Obviously, one can see, in the highlighted portion of these verses, that unity is a result of the love of Christ poured into us that in turn needs to pour out of us toward everyone we encounter even if that love isn't returned to us in kind. Simply put "Unity" with the Spirit along with one another results in joy and joy results in action toward others with respect to the gospel message as intended. In his recent editorial Todd Unzicker, EDT of the Baptist State Convention of North Carolina, mentioned, when talking about cooperation which leads to unity that we as believers and NC Baptist should "now more than ever, understand cooperation is vital to our mission of making Christ's name known among the nations. As autonomous churches, we each function in our own context, style and strengths, but we (believers or NC Baptists should – my addition) link arms for the sake of the gospel. Our shared identity as God's people means He calls us to go on mission together, bringing the hope of Jesus to all people." Please join me in the task of continuing our efforts, here in the SFBA, to maintain our unity as we cooperate together for the sake of the Gospel.
